Humana to Host Biennial Investor Meeting

LOUISVILLE, KY (March 11, 2019) – As previously disclosed, Humana Inc. (NYSE: HUM) will be hosting an Investor Meeting in New York City on Tuesday, March 19, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. eastern time. The Investor Meeting will include a number of presentations by company leaders focusing on Humana's strategic direction, operational and financial progress as well as expectations for future performance.

Humana encourages the investing public and media to listen to its Investor Meeting via the Internet since attendance at the event is by invitation only. The Investor Meeting webcast and virtual presentation may be accessed via Humana's Investor Relations page at humana.com. The company suggests web participants sign on approximately 15 minutes in advance of the event. The company also suggests web participants visit the site in advance to run a system test and to download any free software needed.

Financial Guidance Update

For the year ended December 31, 2019 (FY 2019), Humana's management expects to reaffirm its Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) guidance range of approximately \$16.60 to \$17.10 in diluted earnings per common share (EPS), or approximately \$17.00 to \$17.50 in adjusted earnings per

common share (Adjusted EPS). This guidance is consistent with the guidance reaffirmed in Humana's Form 8-K filing dated February 28, 2019.

Adjusted EPS should be considered in addition to, but not as a substitute for, or superior to, GAAP EPS. A reconciliation of GAAP EPS to Adjusted EPS follows:

GAAP	~\$16.60 to \$17.10
Amortization of identifiable intangibles	0.40
Adjusted (non-GAAP) – FY 2019 projected	~\$17.00 to \$17.50

The company has included Adjusted EPS in this release, a financial measure that is not in accordance with GAAP. Management believes that this measure, when presented in conjunction with the comparable measure of GAAP EPS, is useful to both management and its investors in analyzing the company's ongoing business and operating performance. Consequently, management uses Adjusted EPS as an indicator of the company's business performance, as well as for operational planning and decision making purposes.
